The 12<sup>th</sup> ICAANE Organizing Committee invites applications for the "Ancient Ice Prize," consisting in two grants offered, on a competitive basis, by the Carpigiani Gelato Museum (Carpigiani Group – ALI Group Srl) located in Via Emilia, 45 Anzola dell'Emila (BO) Italy.

Since 1946 Carpigiani (<a href="www.carpigiani.com">www.carpigiani.com</a>) established itself as the market leader in the production of machines for gourmet gelato, better known as Italian-style ice cream. Today the company is deeply involved in the cultural diffusion of the frozen dessert art with a globally recognized museum (<a href="www.gelatomuseum.com">www.gelatomuseum.com</a>) and the most successful school for aspiring gelato entrepreneurs (<a href="www.gelatouniversity.com">www.gelatouniversity.com</a>).

The aim of the Ancient Ice Prize is to contribute to the improvement of the current knowledge and understanding of the archaeology and history of food practices in the Ancient Near East, focusing on the cold food production, storage and consumption. *NOTE: papers for this prize do not need to be presented by applicants in the Congress program.* 

The Ancient Ice Prize consists in two grants, each one of 1,000 €, on the following topics:

- Category 1. The best original scientific paper on the archaeology and history of food in the Near East (any period between the later prehistory and the early Islamic era), focusing on the practice of cold food production, storage and/or consumption. There is no word and images limit. The winning paper may be published anywhere the author wishes so, with an acknowledgement to the support obtained by the Gelato Museum.
- Category 2. The best state-of-the-art paper summarizing cold food production, storage systems and consumption patterns from the later prehistory to the Islamic period in the Near East, using both archaeological and historical sources. The paper should not be less than 6,000 and not exceed 10,000 words (references excluded) plus tables and images. Images under copyright are allowed, the Museum will in case ask for the release of rights. The winning paper will become property of the Gelato Museum.

## CONDITIONS

- 1. Applicants to the Ancient Ice Prize must be officially registered to the 12th ICAANE.
- 2. Scientific papers submitted for the Ancient Ice Prize may be also presented to the 12th ICAANE (as a paper or poster), following the standard procedure <a href="https://eventi.unibo.it/12icaane/submission-form">https://eventi.unibo.it/12icaane/submission-form</a>
- 3. Papers submitted for the Ancient Ice Prize must be sent to the official 12th ICAANE email (12icaane@unibo.it) before the deadline of March 14th, 2021 to allow the Organizing Committee and the Curators of the Gelato Museum to evaluate them.







4. Papers submitted for the Ancient Ice Prize must be written in one of the official ICAANE languages (English, French, German, Spanish, Italian), although English is preferred. Enquiries about topics etc. may be addressed to caterinaghelfi@carpigiani.it.

## DOCUMENTATION TO BE SUBMITTED

In order to be eligible for the Ancient Ice Prize, participants must send the documentation to <a href="mailto:12icaane@unibo.it">12icaane@unibo.it</a> with an Object "Ancient Ice Prize paper, category ..." (1 or 2, see above). The following documents must be attached to the email:

- 1. Paper including title, author(s) name and affiliation(s), text, reference, tables and captions in .doc format. Footnotes may be included only for papers of category 1. References should be included in the text following the Harvard system (name, year) for both categories.
- 2. B/W or colour images in .jpg format (at least 300 dpi).
- 3. Proof of enrollment obtained after the official registration to the congress.

Selection of papers will be carried out by the 12<sup>th</sup> ICAANE Organizing Committee and the Curators of the Gelato Museum in time for the opening of the Congress: the Selection Committee reserves the right to not assign the grants if the papers received will not be deemed worthy by an unanimous vote. Ancient Ice Prize winners will be announced on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> April 2021 on the website of the Congress. The Gelato Museum will correspond the two grants (one for the winner of each Category) in cash or bank wire as applicable.
